WritingLesson ProcedureInitial Control and Motivation

Teacher began by giving a story about the origin of the letter 'p'. The class was asked to participate through a questioning ~~teacher~~ technique and the result was very eager participation. Teacher also explained that it was much harder for him to write on the blackboard than for them to write into their books, therefore their writing should be twice as good as the teachers.

Main Stages of Presentation

## (i) Teacher demonstration.

## (iii) Supervision of work.
